May 20th Dinosaurs /Geology		Mike Cleeland	Celebrate the discovery of the first Australian Dinosaur fossil near Eagles Nest. Mike will tell us about the 120-million-year old geology and the dinosaurs that have been fossilised in the layers of sedimentary mudstone.
July 22nd Bush reserve		Jenny Reskje	Jenny will take us on a walk through this large reserve where we will look at the plants and orchids growing there.
September 23rd Wonthaggi Public Land		Aileen Vening	Wonthaggi is surrounded by large expanses of public land as a legacy of coal mining. Aileen will guide a walk around a selection of these reserves and their significant flora and fauna and we will hear about their history.
